**VII.** Finance Report and Approvals (Action)

Lon noted no unusual activity and stated that taxes had been remitted timely. 13 BARS. Cash Adjustment, truing up to the amounts we actually have. Increase BAR for CSLD money, this is actually money we received for a grant. Increase in state match, booked for maintenance or tech, is an increase of PED allocation. Carl Perkins, an increased BAR. Multiple Cash Adjustments, not actual revenue. Transfer BAR, clean up of Title 1. Multiple Community School Grant for Maintenance, another adjustment. Decrease from state matched money, not losing money, but moving money down to audited cash, one cash audited adjustment. The increase in adjustment indicates we were conservative in our budgeting.

We pulled a random sample and requested and received support and saw that the internal controls are functioning. As a finance committee we are monitoring internal controls.

Expenditure Comparisons, we are down month over month, this is consistent between both years.

SEG will go up a little over \$22,000.

Instructional Support and function code. This is a lower percentage than they receive in training, but we are a small school and unique.

Balance Sheet, \$1.9 million in cash, \$100,000 in current liabilities.

Cash reconciles. We have manly cash, this is a good thing to have.

P-Card-Some items purchased on P-Card. School has done very well.

Journal Entries-Small journal entries. Corrections to change codes. Great level of detail being tracked. Reclassification of general supplies from operational to instructional material.

Next is Lease to Purchase Agreement, we have Capital Outlay money to develop new land, we can not spend that money until we have a Lease to Purchase for the land. This will slow things down.
