Matt Salas: Updated the Board on important dates and

Matt shared that exhibitions went well and included 2 off-site projects. Enrollment continues to be strong. June 3rd is the next community Market from 10am-2pm at ACE. There will be 60 vendors and the community are invited to attend.

Casey Mason: Provided an overview of testing and important dates to help wrap up the year. The students are becoming more comfortable with standardized testing.

XI. Items for Board Discussion and Action

- High level 6-month overview of strategic plan (discussion only)
 - Justin pointed out that the 6-month review of the strategic plan was shared as a board document which reflects major school activities.
- Training Deadline, April 30th(discussion only)
 - Justin also reminded the Board that the training needs to be done by the end of the month.
- FY 2024 Budget Approval

Sammi Marquez presented an overview of the budget for the upcoming school year. Sammi reviewed the major impacts to the schools specific funding formula some of which are: the 13.58% at risk index increase which is school specific, a -6.22% state equalization guarantee decrease, and a -20% small school size adjustment has been phased out. There is a 6% raise for all employees, with state minimums of \$25,000 for educational assistant minimum, \$50,000 for

level 1 teachers, \$60,000 for level 2 teachers, \$70,000 for level 3 teachers, and \$80,500 for principals, with a high school factor of 1.65 ratio. Sammi noted compensation and benefits are a total of 66% of the budget. After a brief conversation Sammi was thanked for the presentation and hard work on the budget. With the understanding that PED will be reviewing the budget, the motion was made to conditionally approve the budget pending final approval by the PED with possible budget changes.
